

Grant Partner Spotlight

In 2020, Mannifera provided seed-funding to establish the Australia Democracy Network (ADN), and have proudly renewed our support ever since. In 2021, ADN led the Hands Off Our Charities Alliance to victory by defeating regulations that would have stifled the right for charities to engage in advocacy. They also collaborated with a range of organisations to block Voter ID legislation that would have prevented marginalized communities from casting a ballot. In 2022, ADN supported coalitions that increased female representation in parliament and reformed the MPs' Code of Conduct.
